At KTS+ we prepare our students for life after KTS Academy. Our aim is to provide them with enjoyable learning experiences which will lead to employment, training and further education.

Our Curriculum is personalised to meet the needs of individual students and provide them with opportunities to:



- Develop and extend existing knowledge (focus on functional literacy and numeracy);
- Gain accreditation in a variety of subjects;
- Develop skills for working life, independent living and community contribution;
- Explore their values, opinions and view of the world as young adults.

At KTS+, the students follow the Post 16 Study Programme and therefore take part in the following lessons:



Functional Skills English and Maths

This is a widely recognised qualification that all students study at KTS+ which can be used when applying for colleges or work placements.

Independent Living Qualification (Entry Level 1 and 2) or Skills for Employment, Training and Personal Development Qualification (Entry Level 3)

All students need to learn about life skills to help them become independent adults. Each day the students are involved in a lesson which focuses on different skills from washing and ironing to applying for jobs at the level they are studying.

Pathways Subjects and Work Placements

These subjects are designed to give the students a taster of what they would like to do when they leave KTS Academy. This year the subjects are: Art, Media, Catering, Horticulture, Animal Care, Motor Mechanics and Maintenance. Every student takes place in a work placement each week, which is based on the individuals areas of interest and possible future placements.

Students also run a Community Café each Friday morning that is open to the public. Everyone is Welcome!
