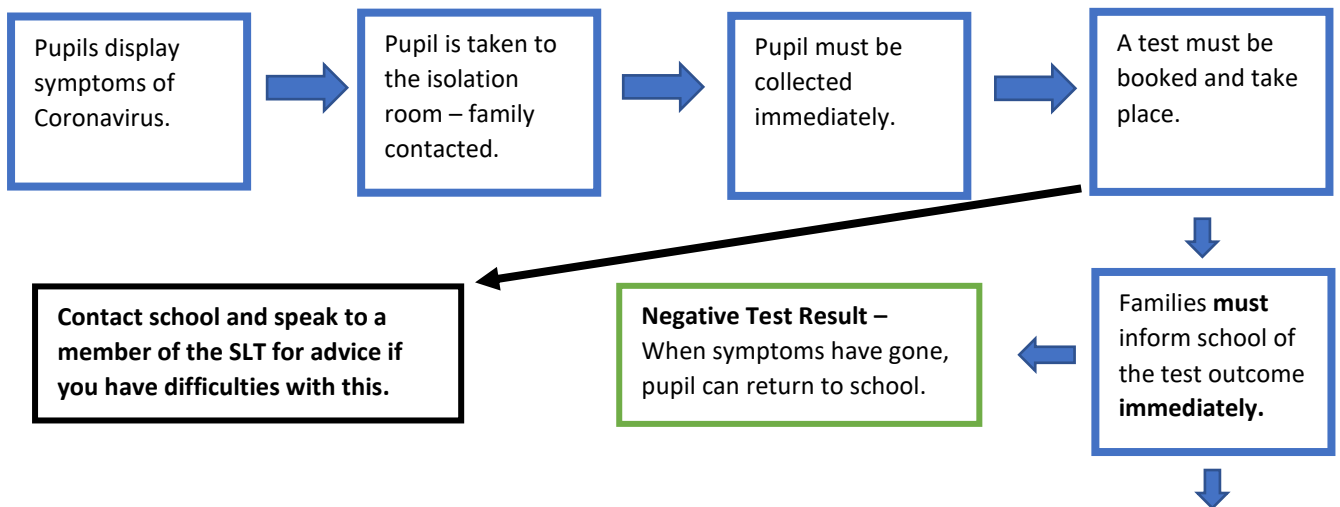




### The main symptoms of Coronavirus are:

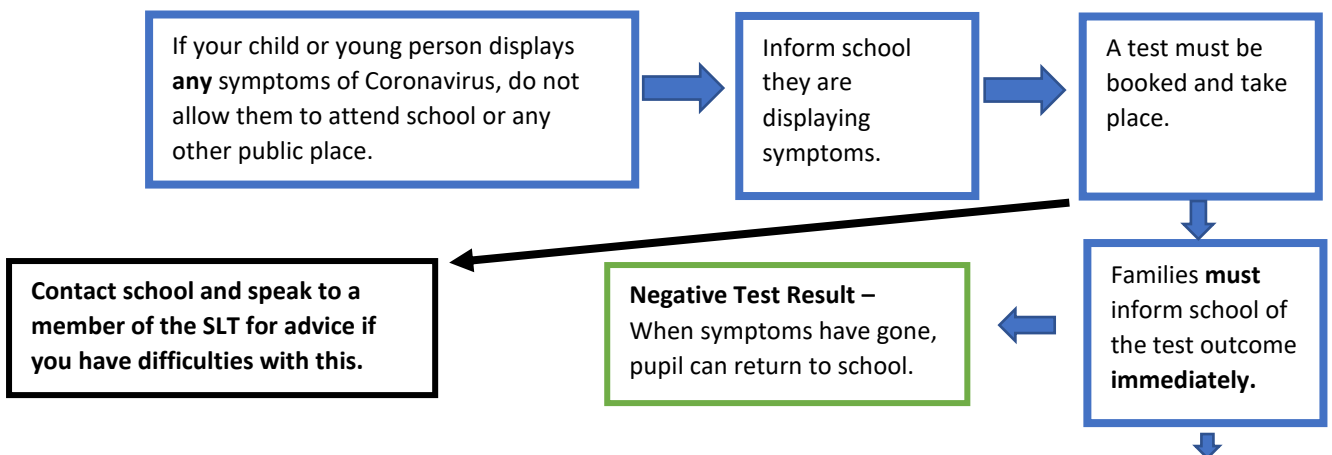
- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A loss of taste or smell

### School response if a pupil displays any of these symptoms during school time



**Positive test result** – Pupil must stay at home for 10 days from when the symptoms started. Your household must isolate for 14 days and anyone developing symptoms must be tested. School will engage with the local Public Health Protection Team and follow advice. Close contacts in school will be advised to stay at home for 14 days. If they develop symptoms during the 14 days they should book a test and start their isolation period again for 10 days.

### What if my child/young adult displays any of these symptoms at home?



**Positive test result** – Pupil must stay at home for 10 days from when the symptoms started. Your household must isolate for 14 days and anyone developing symptoms must be tested. School will engage with the local Public Health Protection Team and follow advice. Close contacts in school will be advised to stay at home for 14 days. If they develop symptoms during the 14 days they should book a test and start their isolation period again for 10 days. School must be informed of any positive results.
